We are faced with increasingly unquestionable evidence of the impact that human activity and the built environment has on the environment. Labeling our current era as anthropogenic is giving a sense of urgency to addressing a new *sustainability beyond sustainability*.

The built environment is currently a significant contributor to wider and global sustainable impacts, but can be a significant contributor to sustainability success. However, as Naomi Klein commented in *This Changes Everything*, "there are no non-radical solutions available to us" and as Martin Brown noted in *FutureRestorative* "we no longer have the luxury of being less bad".

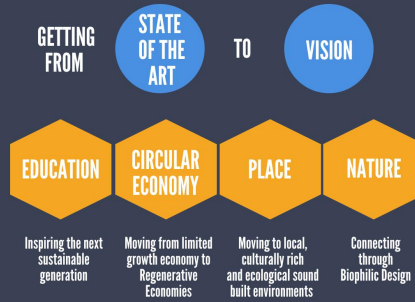
